

LAWS WHICH AFFECT COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

(All Colleges and Universities)

SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973

No otherwise qualified individual with a disability in the United States . . . shall, solely by reason of his or her disability, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

(Public Colleges and Universities)

TITLE II THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

Subject to the provisions of this title, no qualified individual with a disability shall, by reason of such disability, be excluded from participation in or be denied the benefits of the services, programs or activities of a public entity, or be subjected to discrimination by such entity.

(Private Colleges and Universities)

TITLE III THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

No individual shall be discriminated against on the basis of disability in the full and equal enjoyment of the goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, or accommodations of any place or public accommodation by any person who owns, leases (or leases to), or operates a place of public accommodation.
