Student Support Services Program

Serving first generation, low income and students with disabilities needing support services

- 160 Participants enrolled in the SSS Program
- 97% In good academic standing at FGCU
- 45 New members admitted to SSS in fall 2008
- 39 Graduated from FGCU in spring of 2008
- 142 Students participated in Peer Advocate Program
- 2,263 Visits to the SSS computer lab for support
- \$57,244 Grant Aid & E & G funding for 2007-2008 participants



College Reach Out Program (CROP)

Serving educationally underrepresented, first generation and low income 6-12th grade students

- 597 Students in 24 schools from 3 counties participated in 2007-2008
- 24 On-site Coordinators worked directly with FGCU CROP staff members
- 71% Enrollment rate in higher education for CROP graduates
- 3,240 Hours of SAT Preparation provided by FGCU CROP staff
- 10,472 Hours of Mentoring and Motivational Activities provided to school sites
- 62,296 Hours of tutoring provided by on-site CROP Program Coordinators



Public Schools Enrichment Partnership (PSEP)

Serving underrepresented students in grades 4-16 by FGCU

- 1020 Students in 32 schools from 4 counties participated in 2007-2008
- 700 Students were educated in 27 "College for a Day" tours at FGCU
- 27 Students attended the CROP/Scholars summer programs at FGCU
- 675 Students and guests honored at 28 Induction Ceremonies
- 230 Students recognized at the Annual High School Awards Ceremony
- 790 Elementary and Middle School Scholars were honored with awards on-site
