The Testing Center for Florida Gulf Coast University (FGCU) is housed within the Division of Student Affairs, Department of Student Development Services . Located in McTarnaghan Hall, Room 204, we offer 28 workstations containing state-of-the-art computers. Testing is offered at specified times by appointment.
