The purpose of this course is to provide an intensive review of the mathematical skills required to score well on the GRE or GMAT. Mathematics skills needed include arithmetic, algebra, and geometry. This class is not intended to replace a full semester course in any of the above mentioned areas.

Jim Propert A New Jersey native, Jim Propert earned his BA in Mathematics from Lycoming College in Pennsylvania and his M.Ed. from the University of South Florida. He has been teaching all levels of mathematics for 31 years, the last 27 at Cape Coral High School where he coached its nationally recognized Math Team and where he implemented a preparation course for the quantitative section of the SAT. Mr. Propert has been preparing local college graduates for the GRE and GMAT for the past 22 years. He was named Lee County Math Teacher of the Year in 1993, Cape Coral Teacher of the Year in 1994, and the Phi Delta Kappa Educator of the year for K-12 in 2009. Mr. Propert was chosen by the 1996 graduates of Cape Coral High School as commencement speaker. Additionally, he was chosen by the class of 2001 to be commencement co-speaker with his wife Sue. Mr. Propert has just moved from Cape Coral High School to the district office as the new Lee County Coordinator of Secondary Mathematics.
